

# Stampin' Savvy CARD SKETCH - Blueprint #109 (Diagonal Slash)



## TUTORIAL for 2 Cards

SHOP Stampin' Up! Supplies in the USA at [StampinSavvy.com/Shop](https://www.stampinsavvy.com/Shop)

**WHISPER WHITE:** 4" x 5-1/4" A2 Card Base (color match to below)

**BASIC GRAY (dark gray) and SMOKY SLATE (light gray):** One each 4-1/2" wide x 5" long (see note below in Savvy Tips and photo on next page). Layer both pieces together, patterns facing up (if applicable) and cut on the diagonal. Switch one piece of each and you now have enough for 2 cards.

**BASIC BLACK:** Focal Point Image of choice

### SAVVY TIPS:

- *This looks great with 2 coordinating patterns of Designer Paper with color-matched cardstock for the card base and color-matched ink for the sentiment!*
- *Cut your diagonal as steep or shallow as you want. It can also go either direction (see photo on next page)*
- *By cutting your top layers at 5" long, it leaves 1/2" for your sentiment. If you need a wider space for your sentiment- say 3/4"- cut layers down to 4-3/4" long. Simply subtract width needed from 5-1/2" to determine final cut*

# Stampin' Savvy CARD SKETCH - Blueprint #109 (Diagonal Slash)

- *Option: Trim card width to 4" and allow your focal point image to hang off the left of your card about ¼". Looks cool & still fits a medium-sized envelope*

## Assembly Directions:

1. Adhere one diagonal piece to card with Multipurpose Glue or SNAIL adhesive.
2. Temporarily place your focal image on card so you know where to start your stamping. Stamp sentiment, keeping it parallel to paper.
3. Adhere second panel on card, using the side of card to serve as your guide to adhere it straight. This will keep your panels parallel to each other correctly. If you need sentiment area a little wider than anticipated, simply trim extra off end after it's adhered.
4. Adhere focal point image with Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Optional: Stamp inside greeting and 'watermark' stamp on back; sign. Stamp or decorate envelope with matching DSP on flap.
